Vision: The vision of the Northern Community Partnerships in Research Grants is to invest in knowledge co-production and relationship building initiatives that:

- Provide a platform and opportunity for Indigenous communities to share their natural science research interests with academic researchers and their students:
- Facilitate novel relationship-building initiatives between Indigenous communities and researchers;
- Support the development of co-produced research projects that focus on protecting and preserving biodiversity in northern Canada; and
- Develop knowledge co-production strategies and demonstrate their importance to the next generation of researchers.

Apply for this program if:

- You are a Principal Investigator at a Canadian accredited university (or equivalent research institute);
- Your research is based in the natural sciences and would support the research priorities presented by the Community;
- You supervise graduate students or postdoctoral fellows;
- You are committed to traveling with your students or postdoctoral fellows to a Community to co-design a research project; AND
- You are relatively confident that your research project will be funded after design with the Community.

This program funds travel to Indigenous Community partners for the purpose of building relationships and designing a research project. It does NOT fund the research project.
