



Northern Biodiversity Research Program:

Northern biodiversity research with conservation impact.

Grants between \$600,000 to \$3,000,000 for projects up to three (3) years.
Supporting research projects that turn results into conservation action to protect and restore northern wildlife and ecosystems.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must be:

- A qualified donee in accordance with the Canada Revenue Agency OR in partnership with a qualified donee.
- Pursuing biodiversity-focused natural sciences research in northern Canada.
- Able to demonstrate that research findings are being or have a realistic chance of being used by conservation decision-makers.

Projects should focus on:

- Population dynamics, ecology, health, disease, contaminants, or management studies of species of importance for northern ecosystems.
- The response of ecosystems to the impacts of climate change.
- The impact of anthropogenic activities on species or ecosystems.
